

Post Season Host Requirements

DISTRICT 39 REQUIREMENTS TO BE A HOST LEAGUE FOR POST SEASON TOC OR DISTRICT ALL STARS
(Umpire requirements for section level and above are the responsibility of the District Staff)

YOUR LEAGUE MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

International

- Have an active Constitution, Charter and Map of league boundary on file
- Have insurance up to date
- Be current on fees to international for players
- Have a current ASAP Safety Program approved and on file

District

- Have approved safety plan in place
- Current on fees to district
- Complete and submit the attached application

League level

Umpire related

- Have an active UIC and Umpire staff
- Host league must have an active UIC who has attended a district or regional clinic
- Be familiar with and prepared to use Arbiter for umpire scheduling
- Have a minimum of 3 umpires attend district umpires preseason clinic with a commitment to be available to officiate games (I suggest 4 attend)
- Schedule and pay all fees related to umpires (payment within 14 days of final game)
(district may assist with final four scheduling and assigning)

Agree to feed players after each game (hot dog and soda)

Complete and submit the application to host post season signed by executive board and UIC

Site and field related

- Tournament Director and Assistant responsibilities
- Committed to being present for all games played and to pass out pins
- Cannot manage or coach any all-star team, or be pitch counter, score keep or announcer, must be impartial (not a fan in the stands)
- Have additional staff based on multiple fields or sites as needed
- Have a score booth staff for each field comprised of 2-3 adults
- Score Keeper
- Pitch Counter
- Announcer
- Have volunteers willing to prep fields for all games
